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The best new hotels and resorts to visit in 2021, from the new Cara Hotel in Los Angeles to Zadún, a Ritz-Carlton Reserve in San Jose del Cabo, Mexico, and more.

Galleria Vik Milano, Italy

Galleria Vik Milano which first opened its doors in late 2019, is Vik Retreat's brand's first city retreat and debut in Europe. Ideally positioned within the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, one of Italy's most iconic landmarks, Galleria Vik Milano is a sanctuary of staggering beauty, with mesmerizing views onto the Galleria and its infamous bull. With its recent comprehensive redesign and renovation, the hotel unveiled remarkable interiors, highlighting artistry from the past and present to celebrate the history and culture of Milan. Upon entering the reception, guests are welcomed by Auguste Rodin's famed bronze sculpture, *The Thinker*, in monumental scale as well as an immersive dry fresco covering the ceiling and walls by Italian artist, Alex Folla. The strong architectural features of the hotel are reinforced with a focus on Italian artwork, in addition to an extensive collection of international art and a mix of curated contemporary, midcentury, vintage and antique furniture. Each corridor boasts a variety of impactful art, some fully covering the walls in a continuum of immersive paintings. Galleria Vik Milano features 89 rooms and suites singularly designed to showcase extraordinary art, décor, views and experiences. The suites are graced by many site-specific installations by Italian, Uruguayan and international artists. Several of the most stunning and spacious were completed this past winter and debuted for the first time this fall with the re-opening of Galleria Vik Milano.

Six Senses New York

The launch of Six Senses New York in 2021 will mark an exciting moment as the pioneering brand makes its foray into North America with its first-ever urban hotel in the United States. The property will be ideally situated directly on the High Line in The XI, a visionary development imagined by revered international architect Barke Ingels. Six Senses New York will also be home to a 45,000 square foot club designed for members and guests, that will include an 18,000 square foot spa, inclusive of a vibroacoustic meditation dome, modern bathhouse, advanced fitness facilities and more.

Cara Hotel - Los Angeles

Each room takes advantage of the Los Angeles sun and iconic Southern California landscape with breezy patios and private courtyard balconies meant to bring the outside in. The hotel strives to create meaningful connections over a shared meal through the inherent generosity of food at **Cara Restaurant** and **Cara Bar & Coffee**. Helmed by Executive Chef Michael Patria, Cara Restaurant invites guests and visitors to discover an elegant and restrained menu that highlights the property's meaningful relationship with its local sustainable farms and the changing, bountiful seasons in California.
