


The Art-Centric Galleria Vik Milano Reopens In Italy


Vik Retreats has announced the reopening of Galleria Vik Milano. The hotel only first opened its doors in late 2019. Located within the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, one of Italy's most iconic landmarks, Galleria Vik Milano offers views onto the Galleria and its infamous bull. The property's opening comes simultaneous to Milan reopening its doors.

The hotel has implemented contactless check-in and checkout for guests, will ensure that rooms have been vacant for at least 48 hours before arrival, and extensive housekeeping will only take place prior to arrival and following departure as part of new practices that have been implemented.
